Whereas, on April 28, 2020, the Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency was extended to May 20, 2020; and

Whereas, on May 19, 2020, the Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency was extended to June 10, 2020; and

Whereas, on June 9, 2020, the Declaration of Local Disaster for Public Health Emergency was extended to July 1, 2020.
