

# NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING AND MEETING OF THE HARRIS COUNTY SALARY GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of the Salary Grievance Committee of Harris County, Texas, will be held on **Tuesday, September 16, 2025, at 10:30 a.m.** in the Courtroom of the Commissioners Court of Harris County, Texas, on the first floor of the Harris County Administration Building, 1001 Preston Street, Houston, Texas.

The meeting will be held for the purpose of conducting a Public Hearing to hear and consider grievances submitted by elected county or precinct officers in Harris County who are aggrieved by the setting of the officer's salary or personal expenses to be included in the 2026 Fiscal Year Budget, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 152.016. Elected officers eligible to submit a grievance include the Constables, County Commissioners, County Attorney, County Clerk, District Attorney, District Clerk, Justices of the Peace, Sheriff, Tax Assessor-Collector, and Treasurer.

At the meeting, the Committee may discuss and act on the following items, as appropriate:

1. Opening remarks and adoption of procedural rules for the Committee.
2. Hearings on grievances submitted pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 152.016(a).
3. Votes and recommendations on grievances.

Members of the public who wish to speak before the Committee must attend the meeting in-person and submit an appearance request form at least one (1) hour before the commencement of the meeting. A member of the public may speak before the Committee for up to one (1) minute in total, regardless of the number of agenda items or topics identified by the speaker.

Members of the public are reminded to conduct themselves with proper respect and decorum while in the presence of the Committee. Any person who fails to behave in an orderly and appropriate manner will be ordered to leave the meeting and recognition to speak may be refused at subsequent meetings of the Committee.

The Committee may announce that it will go into executive session on any item included in this Notice if the subject matter is permitted for a closed session by provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
